Parents have peace of mind leaving their children in the capable hands of qualified teachers and assistants who understand the individual needs of each child. Our teachers have at least 25 years' experience in childhood development.

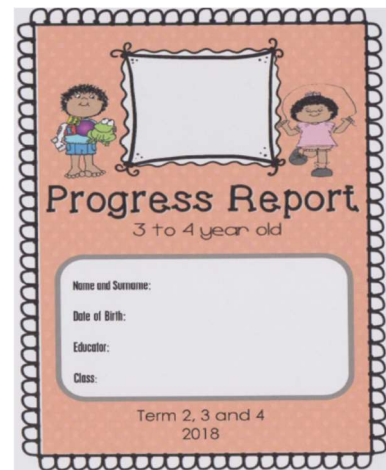
2.1 Quality teaching (CAPS Curriculum)

We follow the CAPS curriculum (Z, 3, 4) as prescribed by the South African Department of Education. Each class has its own curriculum for the year and parents are welcome to view copies thereof at KidsBest. A pre-determined weekly theme is discussed across all age groups to make it interesting.

We are extremely proud of our **Grade R class**, which grows from strength –to-strength. Our Grade R teacher has many years' experience and ensures that all children are prepared for primary school. We are working in collaboration with Wierda Park and Springvale Primary schools to allow absorption of our children into their schools for Grade 1.

Personal progress assessment reports are issued bi-annually to the parents for their information and assistance (if required to address any gaps).

Our daily schedule (hereunder) serves as a framework for operation on a daily basis.

12:00 – 14:00	Lunch time & sleep
14:00 – 14:30	Snack time& toilet routine
14:30 – 17:00	Free play outside
17:30	School closes

2.2 Swimming lessons

Free swimming lessons (including free transport) are provided weekly during normal school terms to pre-primary children. Swimming lessons are provided by qualified swimming instructors at Mariaan Swim School in an indoor, heated swimming pool in Hennops Park.

Swimming is regarded as an essential life skill which also develops the gross motor skills of children.

The swimming school follows the Australian style of teaching, whereby the teachers are in the pool with the children. Performance medals are issued bi-annually, to acknowledge the progress of children in relation to water safety and stroke development.



2.3 Affordable transport to/from home - own vehicles

KidsBest provides transport for its children to/from home.

Our vehicles are branded and tracked for security reasons. We also employ our own drivers. Indemnity from the parents to transport their children is compulsory for each and every child.



2.4 High quality meals

We provide breakfast and lunch, as well as two snacks during the day. A weekly menu is available for parents' information on request, to confirm our commitment in serving well-balanced meals to our children on a daily basis. We adapt this menu based on the childrens' feedback.

We also cater for vegetarians and take any individual allergies into account.

Parents must provide milk for their babies.

2.5 Secure premises and parking



We are proud to confirm that we meet City of Tshwane regulations in relation to the number of parking bays (19) for teachers and our parents. Our parents are not allowed to park outside the premises to drop-off or collect their children, as this is against legislation.

The electronic gate is managed on a full-time basis from inside the facility, to ensure proper access control. All visitors must sign the visitor's log.

2.6 Creative and well-developed play-ground

A child must play!!

With reference to our daily activity schedule, it is evident that we allow ample time for free play, whether inside or outside.

Our outside playground is well equipped with multiple apparatus and a huge under cover sandpit. Artificial grass was laid for the convenience of our children and for esthetic reasons.

Children and monitored at all times during freeplay.



2.7 Fully equipped, well-maintained facility

KidsBest has at least 6 classrooms with 6 ablution facilities. The structure is well maintained, cleaned and organized.

3. Fee Structure

Our fees are affordable and appears to be the best in Centurion, considering the quality of service, food and swimming lessons we offer.

Kindly refer to the attached fee structure for your information.

Terms of payment:

- Registration of a child is compulsory, before a child can attend to school
- KidsBest's management need to confirm that space is available, prior to the submission of the registration form and the proof of payment. "First come first serve" basis.
- **No payment in December** for learners who joined and paid school fees from January of a calendar year
- The registration fee is payable at the time of registration
- The monthly school fee is payable in advance on or before the 3rd day of the month, or on the day the school opens in January
- Additional family discount of R100 per child, per month, will be applicable, should you register more than one family learner
- **Free swimming lessons**, including transport to and from Mariaan Swim School, during school quarters (please sign the indemnity for transport)
- **Meals included**
- All stationary is provided by KidsBest

Transportation fees & information:

- Transportation fees are per child per month
- Approximate pick-up and drop-off time to be agreed between KidsBest management and the parent/s in advance
- KidsBest will not tolerate any delays at the point of collection or drop-off
- Parents acknowledge that the time of pick-up and collection may alter as a result of circumstances beyond its control (traffic, etc)
- Additional charges may be applicable outside normal routes
- Kidsbest management may appoint sub-contractors under extreme circumstances, but parents will be notified accordingly

4. Rules & Indemnity

A list of rules is provided with the registration form. Kindly request a copy thereof from the Kidsbest management team. It is compulsory to acknowledge the rules and sign an indemnity form.
